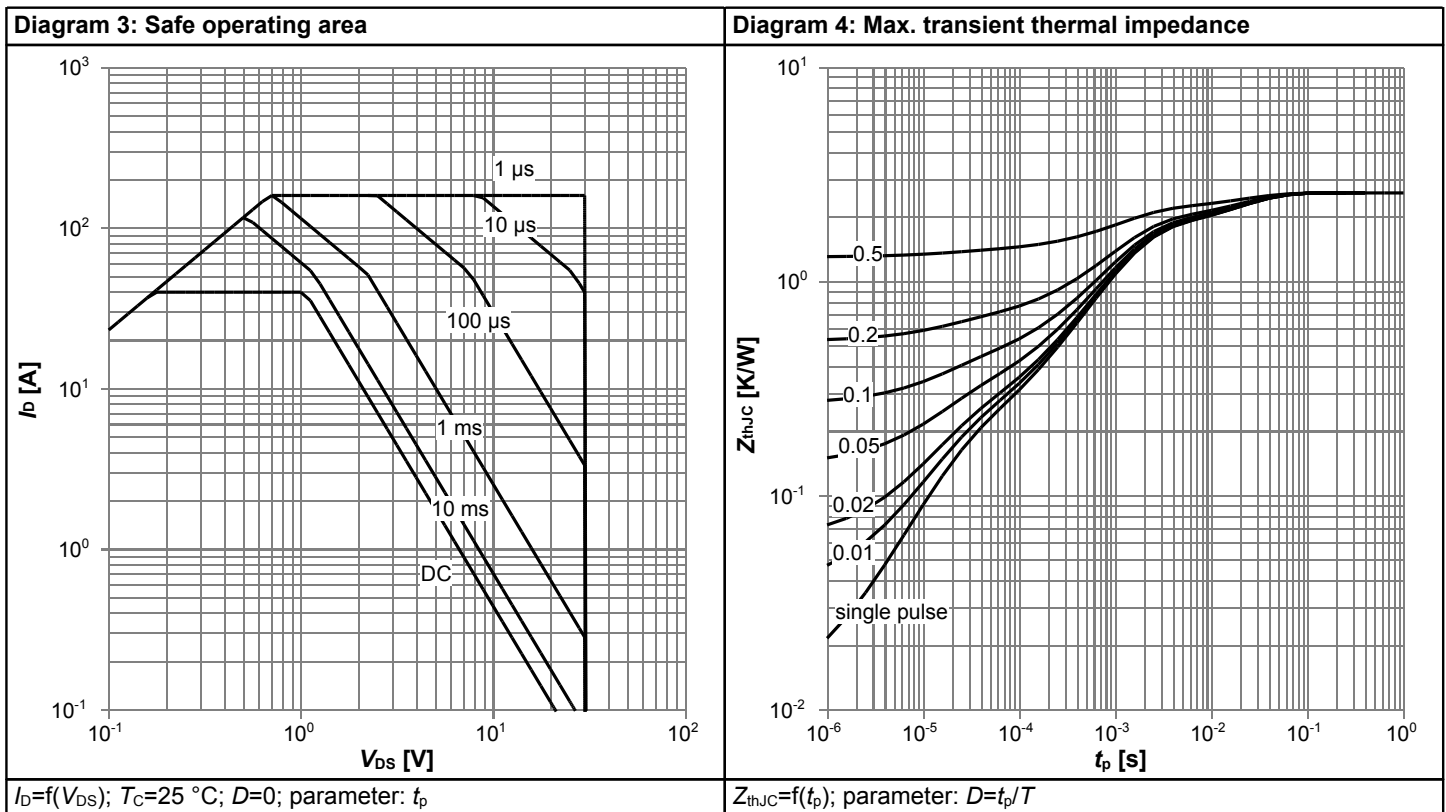
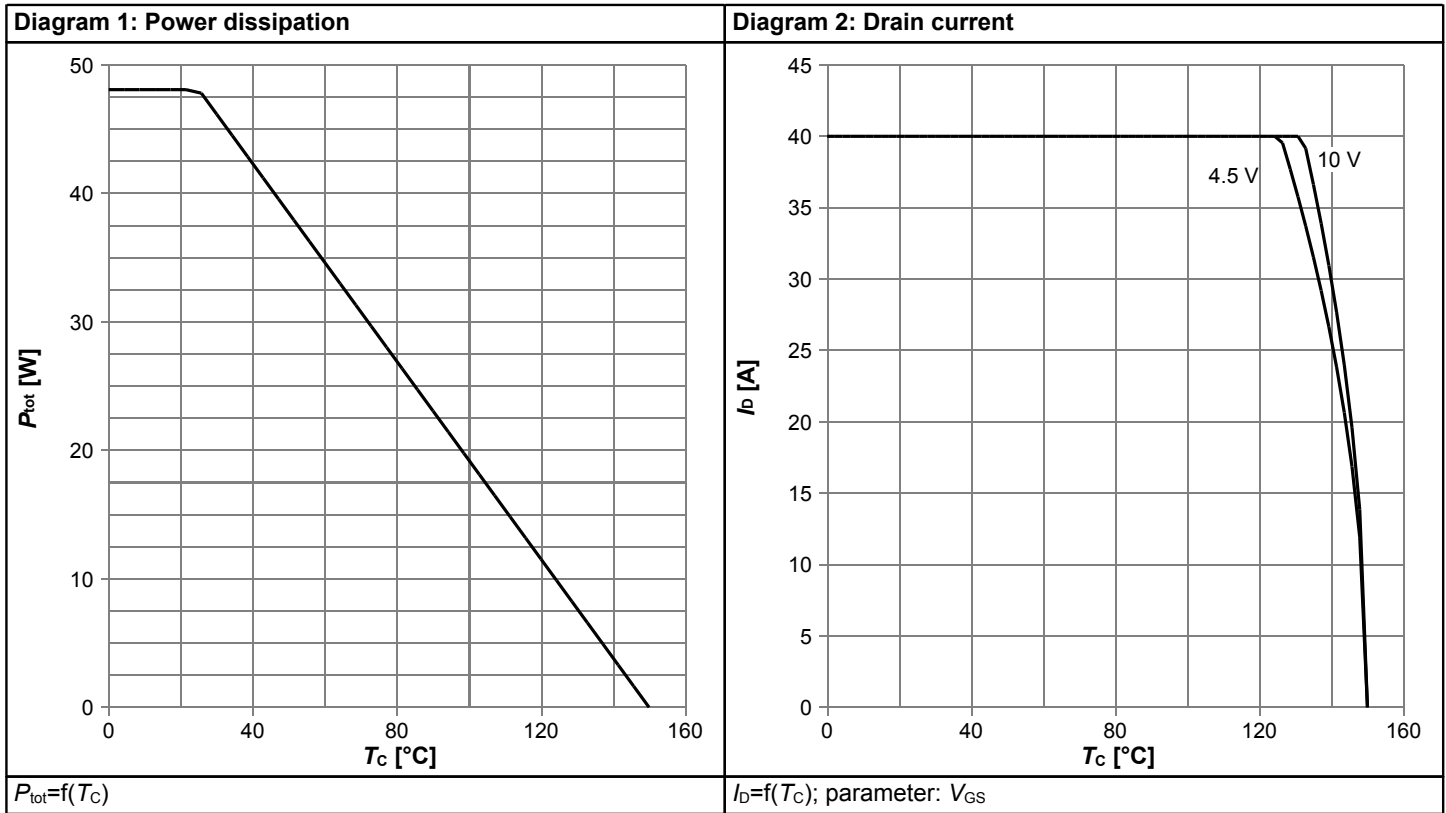
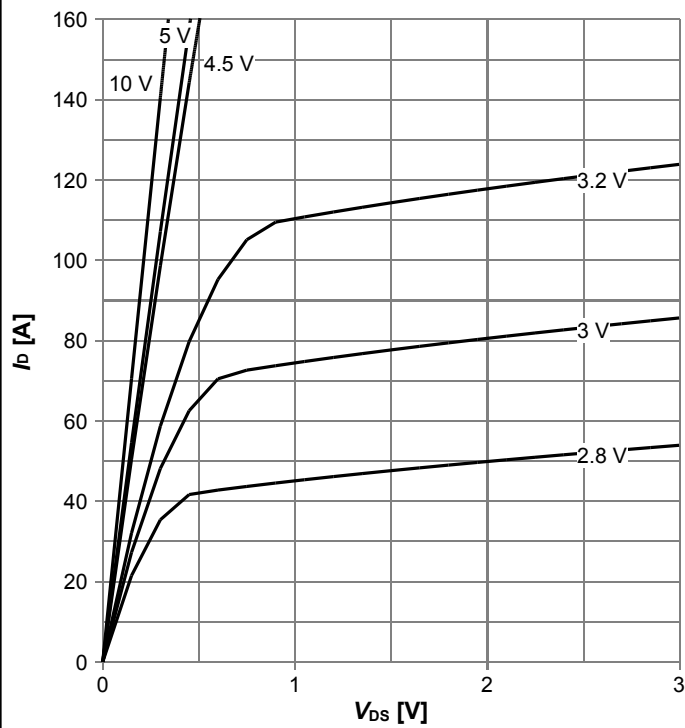
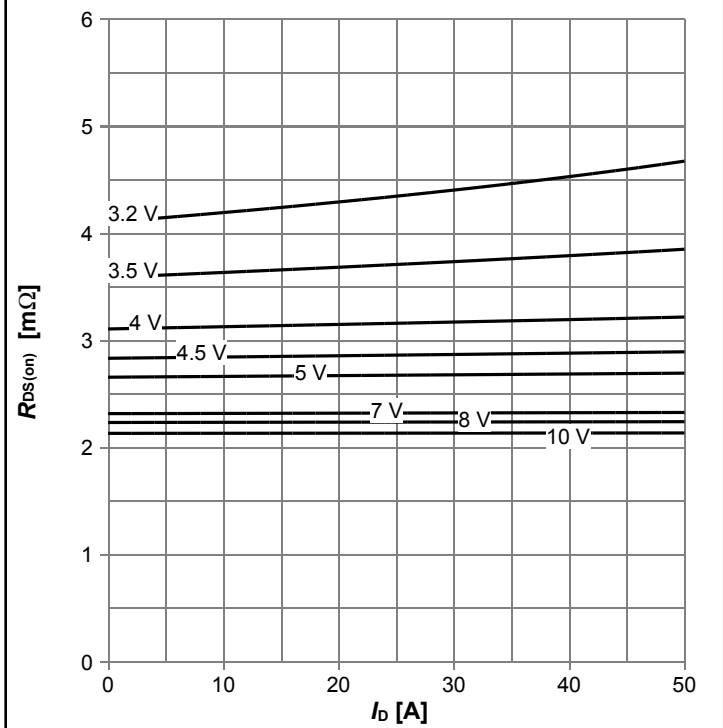


Diagram 5: Typ. output characteristics



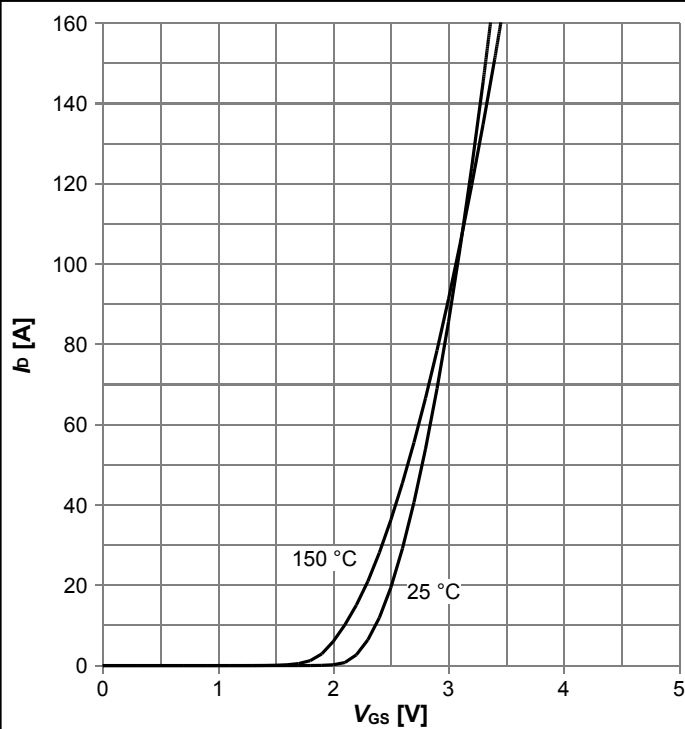
$I_D = f(V_{DS}); T_j = 25\text{ °C};$  parameter:  $V_{GS}$

Diagram 6: Typ. drain-source on resistance



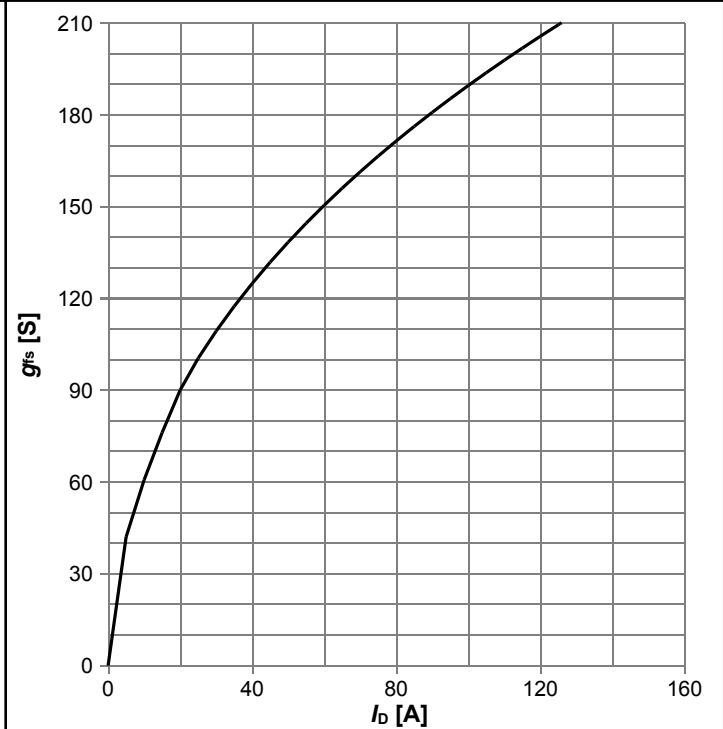
$R_{DS(on)} = f(I_D); T_j = 25\text{ °C};$  parameter:  $V_{GS}$

Diagram 7: Typ. transfer characteristics



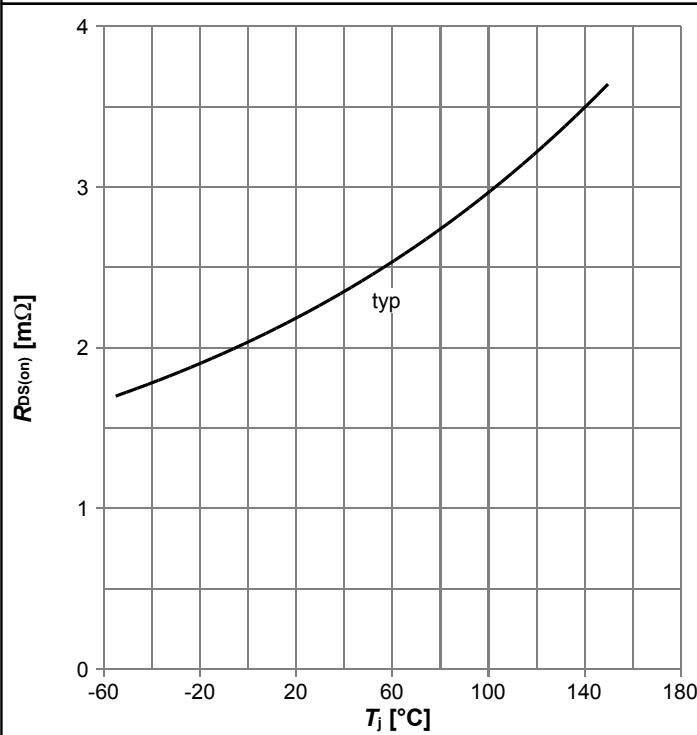
$I_D = f(V_{GS}); |V_{DS}| > 2|I_D|R_{DS(on)max};$  parameter:  $T_j$

Diagram 8: Typ. forward transconductance



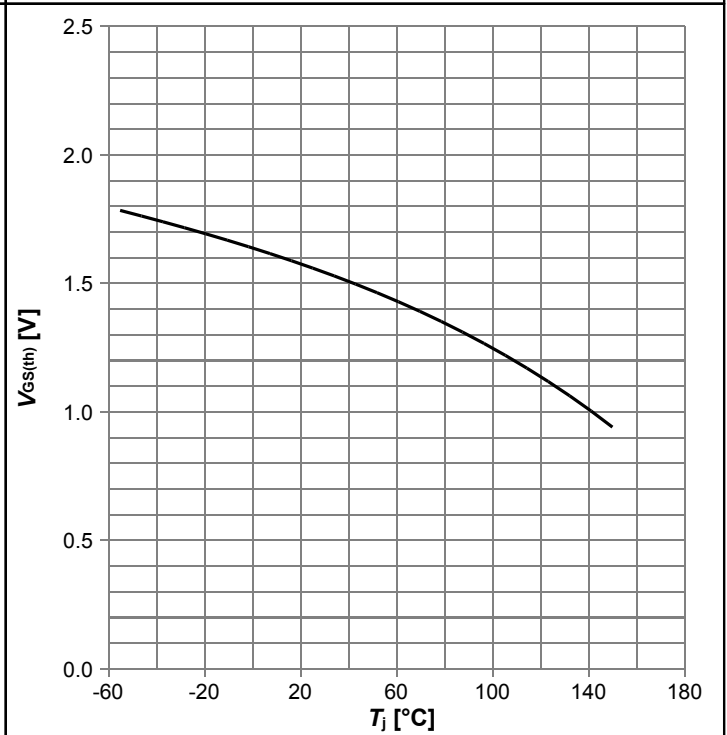

Diagram 9: Drain-source on-state resistance



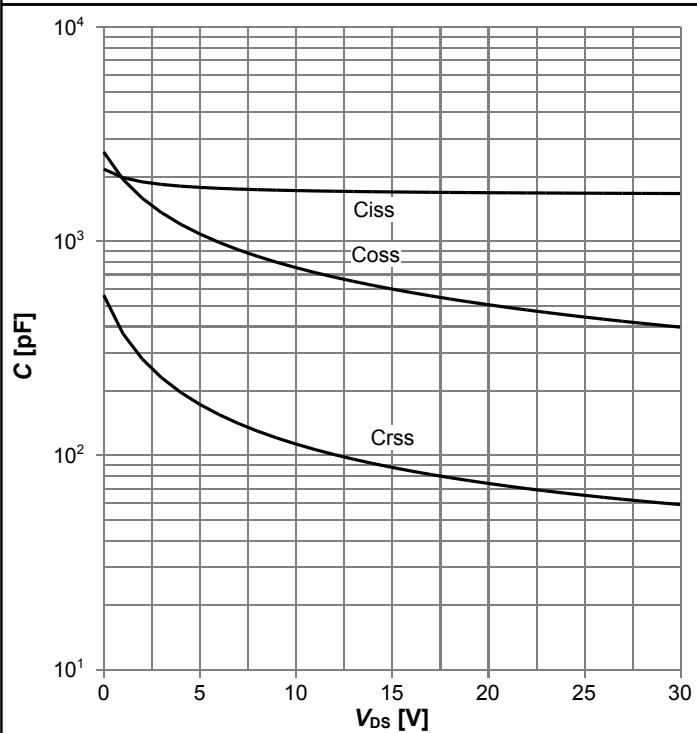

Diagram 10: Typ. gate threshold voltage



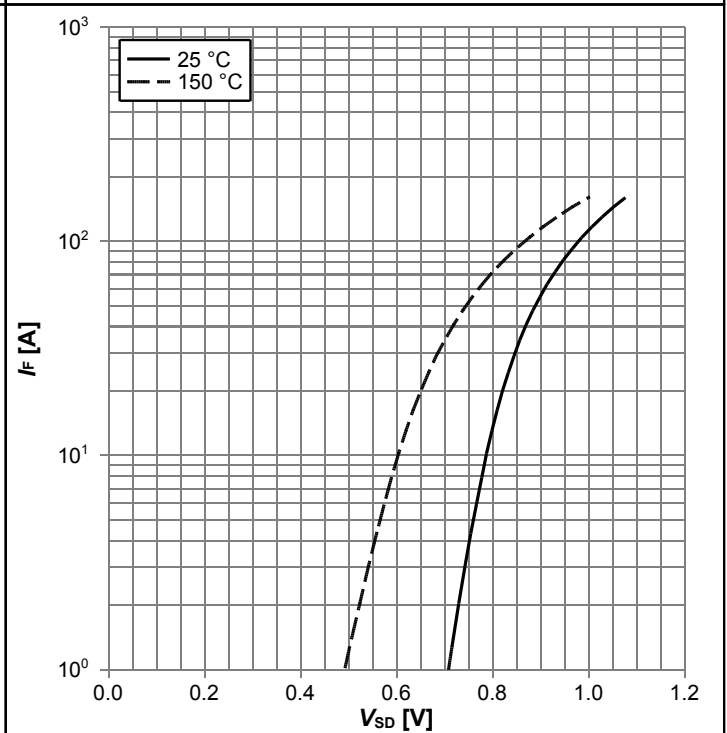

Diagram 11: Typ. capacitances



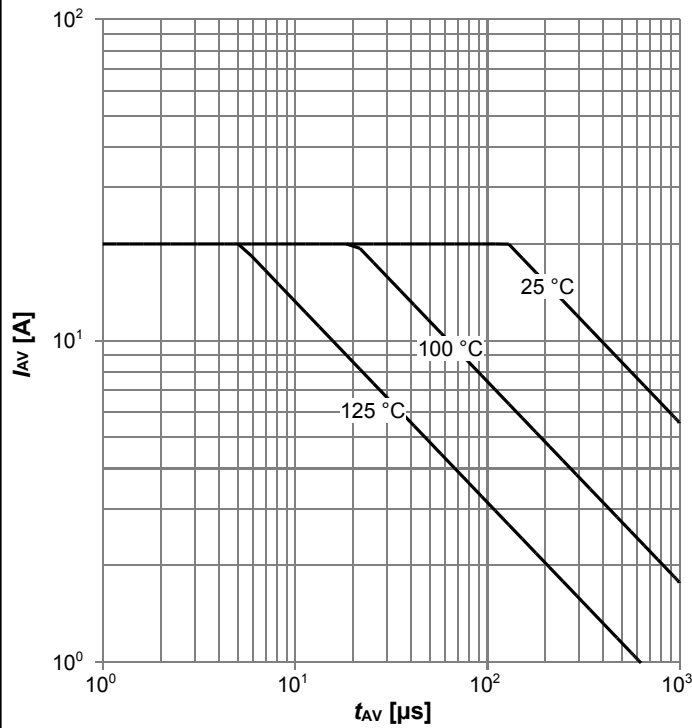

Diagram 12: Forward characteristics of reverse diode



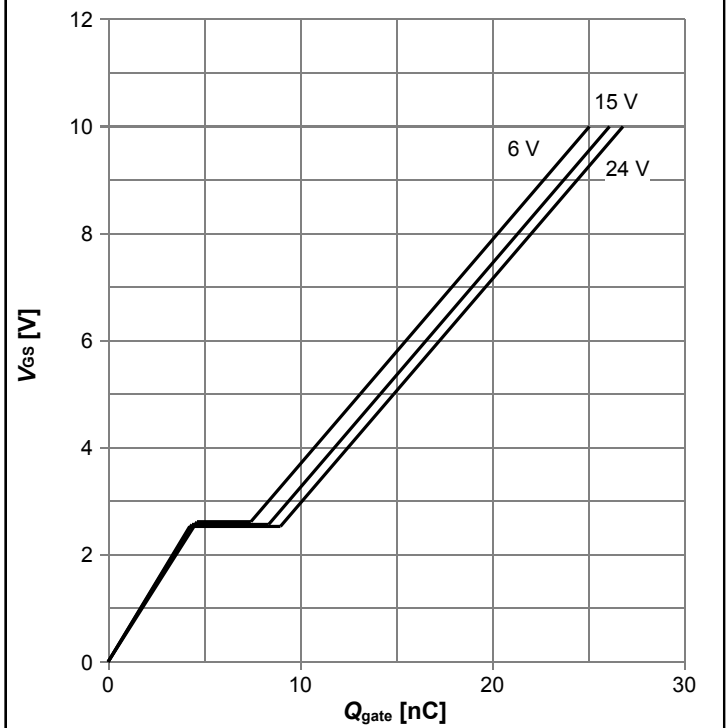

Diagram 13: Avalanche characteristics



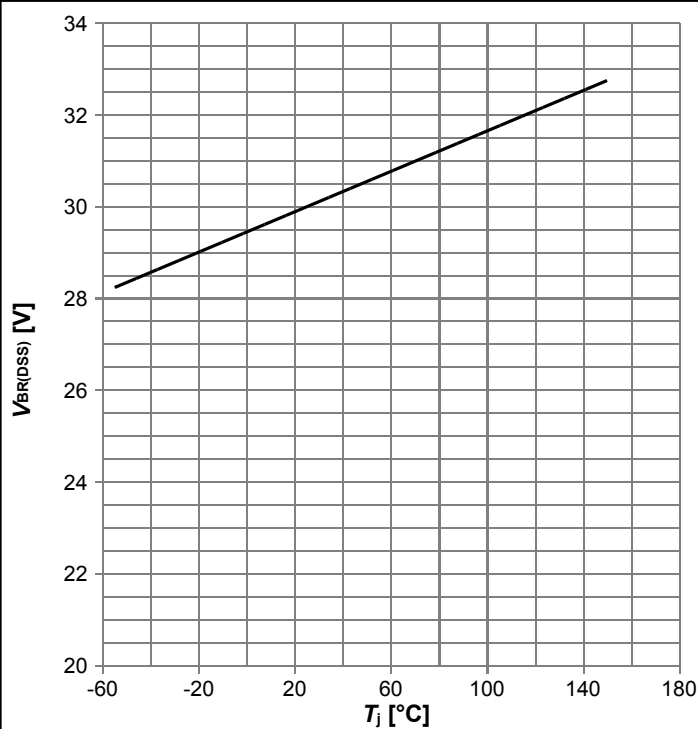

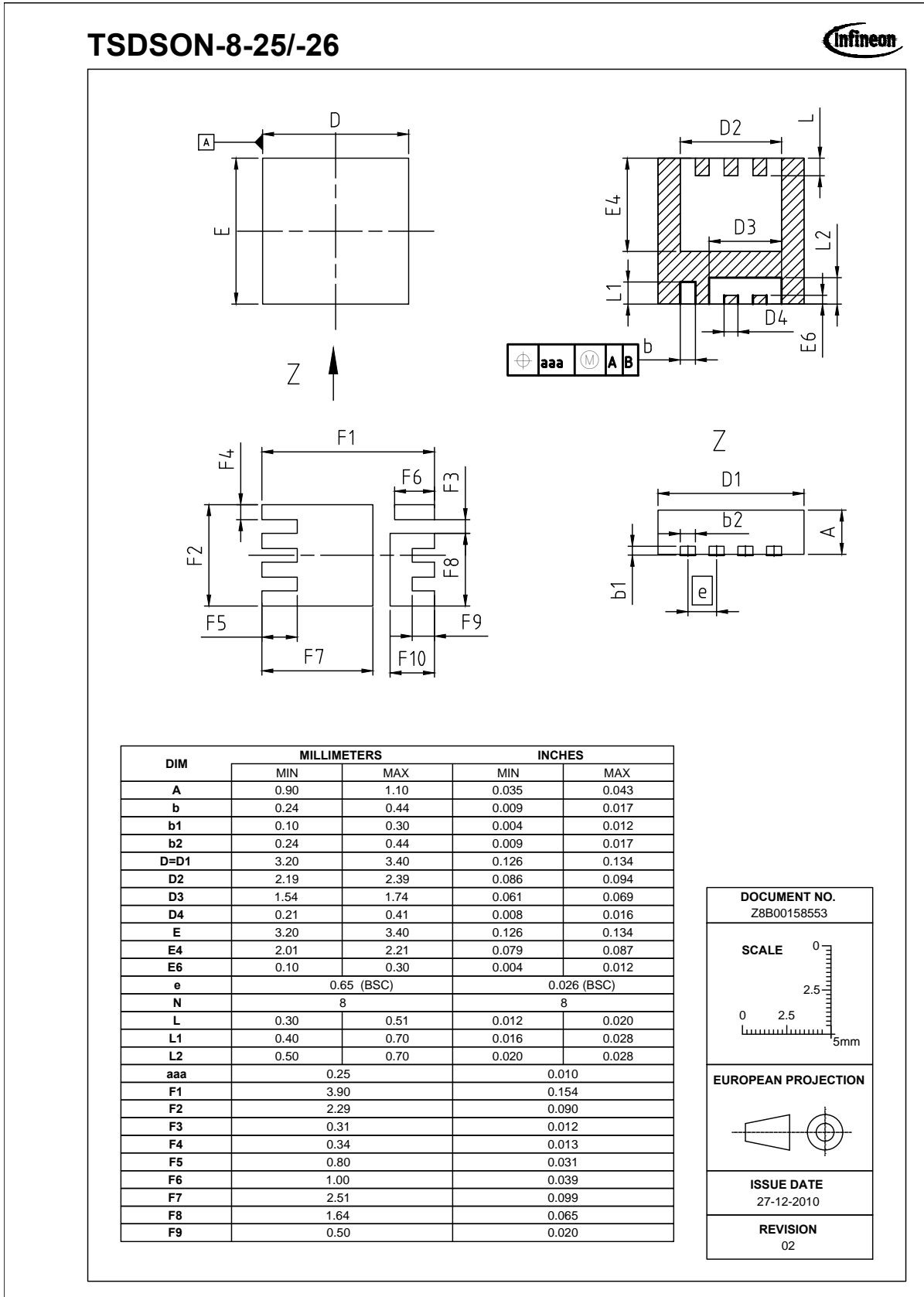


Figure 1 Outline PG-TSDSON-8 FL, dimensions in mm/inches
